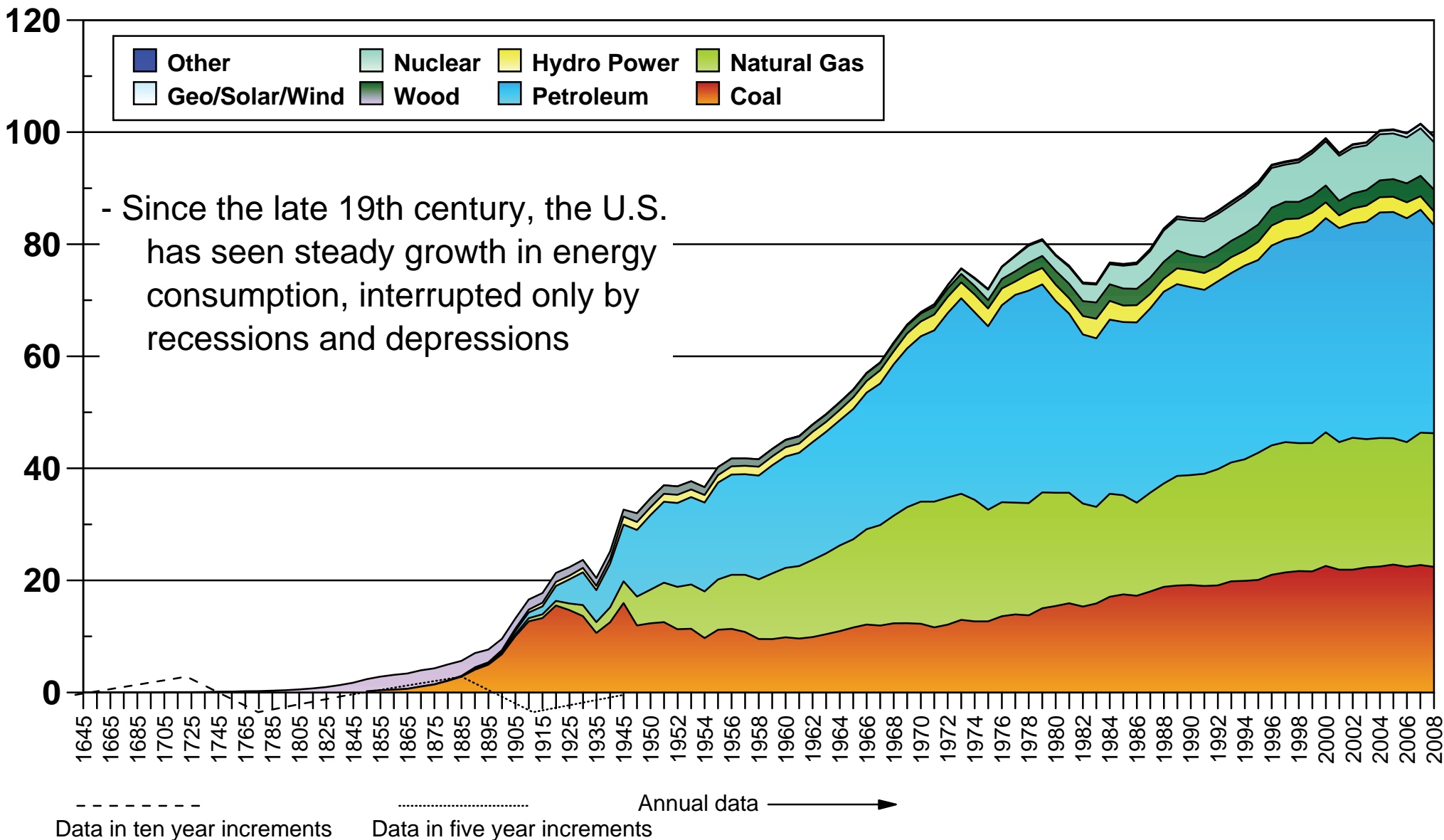


# Figure 1. U.S. Energy Consumption by Source, 1645-2008 (Quadrillion Btu)



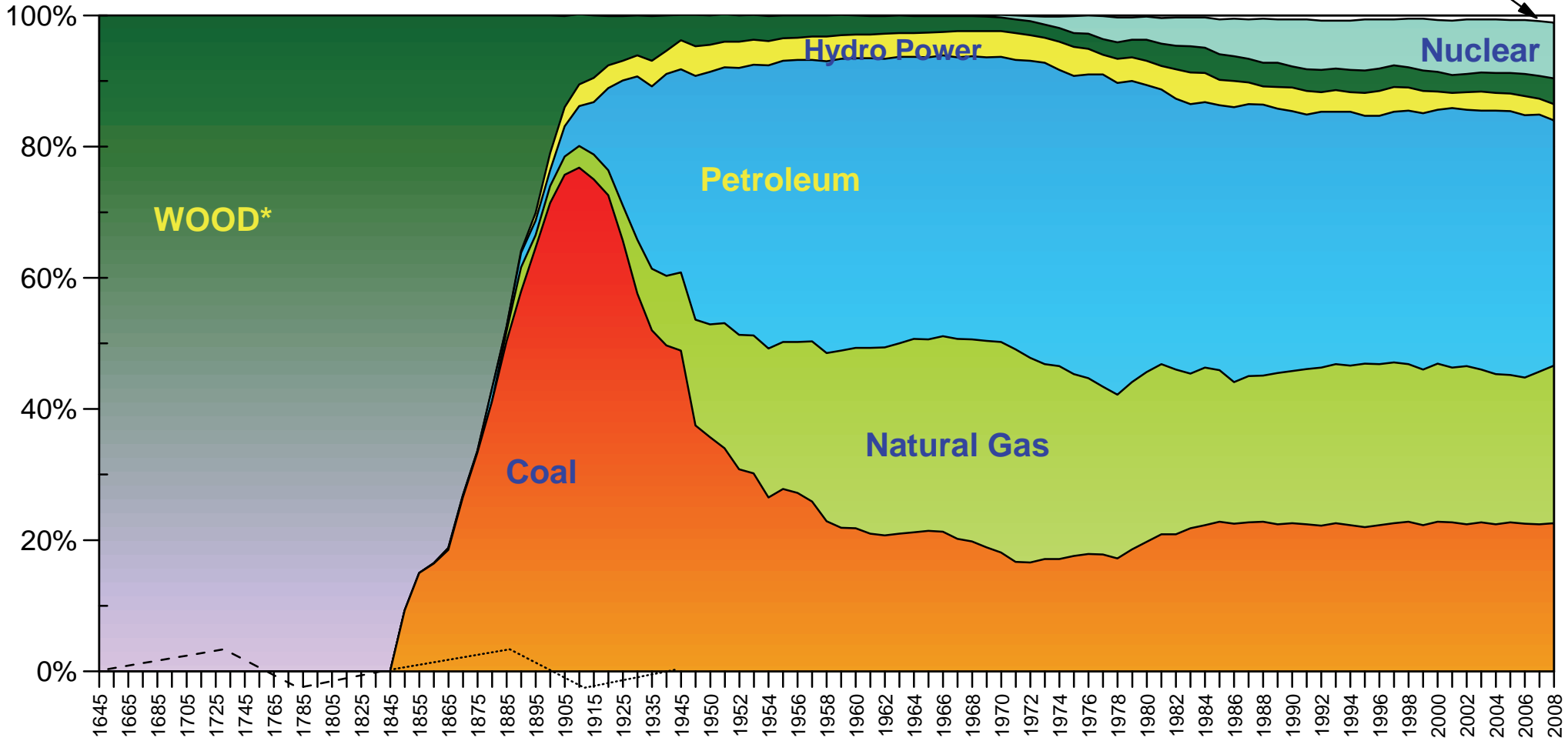
